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ABOUT NOOSAPEC 2026

The Noosa Power & Energy Conference is a curated executive forum focused on the delivery phase of Australia's energy transition.

As the market shifts from ambition to execution, the primary constraints are no longer technical. They sit in coordination across grid reform, industrial capability, workforce alignment, capital deployment, and regional delivery.

NoosaPEC convenes the senior leaders responsible for delivering this transition. This includes decision-makers across energy systems, infrastructure, manufacturing, capital markets, government, and research.

Speakers are invited based on demonstrated delivery experience and their role in implementing projects that shape Australia's energy and industrial future.

The forum brings together leaders across:

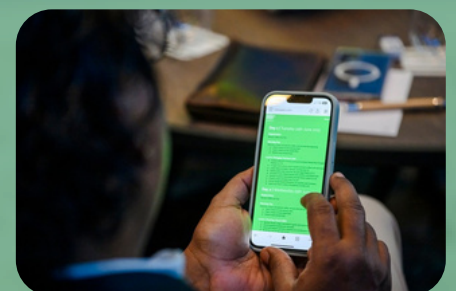

DAY 3: MANUFACTURING ECONOMIC SECURITY

The Future Made in Australia agenda sets a clear ambition: build industrial capability across clean energy, critical minerals and advanced manufacturing.

The opportunity is significant. The challenge is making it commercially viable.

Australia is a high-cost operating environment. Industrial capability will only scale where energy, infrastructure, capital and workforce are aligned in practice.

A forum grounded in commercial reality

Day 3 of NPEC is designed as a real-time pulse check on that alignment. This is not another policy discussion, but rather a working forum bringing together the organisations actively trying to build, invest, hire and deliver.

The discussion focuses on what is happening now:

- Are projects stacking up commercially?
- Where are delays emerging across approvals, infrastructure or financing?
- What is constraining investment, and where can it be unlocked?
- Where are workforce shortages most acute?
- What needs to change now to keep projects viable?
